

Welcome to Style Studio,

We are looking forward to a fun and fashionable summer. This will be our third year at Temple Sharey Tefilo-Israel.

We have three camp sessions this year and will be using



designers from Italy, Haiti and Vietnam as our inspiration.



Our first week of each session will be learning to hand sew, fashion sketching, mood boards, selecting fabric and becoming familiar with machine



sewing. Week two will be spent developing a garment referencing the designer from each country, cutting and stitching it together. We will simultaneously work on accessories and learn to walk the runway. Week three will be spent feverishly finishing our work, a fashion photo shoot and presenting our designs at a fashion show. Each session will have invited guests helping with construction, talking about the industry and teaching modelling.

Our parent Meet and Greet is on Thursday June 21st. at 6:00pm. The Temple Sharey-Tefilo Israel address is 432 Scotland Road in South Orange. We will talk about our daily schedule, answer questions and tour the facility. Below you will find a variety of information and items to hopefully make the first days of camp easier for everyone-the staff, the children and you!



How can my child and I get ready for the first day of camp?

- Have pleasant, positive conversations about what will happen at camp; going over the daily schedule/theme for the week. Talking about friends they will see at camp will help your child feel more comfortable.

- Leave plenty of time on the first day to get ready and eat breakfast. Your child may become upset when you drop them off. Knowing what to expect allows your child to have less anxiety about his/her camp day and starts your day off right too!

List of items that your child will need for camp:

- Lunch in a labeled lunchbox with an ice pack, frozen water or juice box to keep it cold.
- Sneakers! Your child will be moving all day long; playing sports, running, jumping and having fun all day long. For their safety, they need to wear sneakers to participate in all activities safely. Dressy shoes, sandals or flip flops are not recommended.

Please use the Scotland Road drive way to pull into the back-parking lot of the temple. Drop off in the morning for Before Care is 7:00am at the Temples' main entrance by the parking lot. Temple doors are always locked, and you must ring the bell to be allowed entrance.

Drop off between 8:45-9:15am is in the rear of the parking lot where we play every morning from 8:00-9:30am. We are also outside for afternoon pick up between 3:00-4:00pm. In the event of bad weather, campers may be dropped off and picked up from the ballroom at the Temples' main entrance. You must ring the bell to enter the premise. Monday to Thursday aftercare pick up, 4:00-7:00pm, is from the pre-school entrance on Scotland Road. All Friday afternoon pick up is from the Scotland Road pre-school entrance, 3:00-7:00pm due to Temple services.

****As a reminder, if someone other than yourself will be picking up your child, you must fill out an alternate pickup form. Your alternate pick up person will be asked for identification before we will allow your child to leave with them. Please remind them to have this available. If you have a nanny or relative that will be consistently picking up your child, please fill out an alternate pick up slip for them as well.**

During the summer we will be communicating with you through weekly emails. This will be our main source of communication with you so please let us know if there are any changes in your contact information. Photographs are uploaded to Shutterfly daily and may be accessed using info on website. Please feel free to approach Senior Counselors

at any time with questions or concerns. Our staff will be working very hard to make every child happy. Please understand that drop off may not be a convenient time to have a lengthy discussion as the camp has a lot going on during this time. If you feel the need to have a longer conversation, you may call us during the afternoon.

Please label EVERYTHING with your child's name or initials. This helps your child's belongings find their way back to you!

Just a reminder, we are a PEANUT SAFE FACILITY. Please make sure your child comes to camp without any nuts, nut products or peanut butter items. Also, please be sensitive to our host's religious requirements when packing lunches for campers; no pork or shellfish.

Please don't hesitate to call us with any further questions or comments you may have about camp. We are always open to suggestions and ideas.
