I hereby release and discharge the South Mountain YMCA, its agents and employees for any and all claims for injury, illness, death, loss of damage that my child may suffer as a result of his/her participation in any athletic activities, sports programs, the use of equipment or other activities or programming. I assume all risk for my child's participation in those activities.

I understand that the South Mountain YMCA is not responsible for any personal property lost or stolen while in the program. It is recommended that my child does not bring any valuables to program and if need be, can request that a staff person hold anything of value in a safe place until the end of program time.

If parents cannot be reached in an emergency, the South Mountain YMCA will contact the local Rescue Squad and will take your child to the nearest hospital. Continued efforts will be made to reach you.

I, individually and on behalf of my minor child, hereby release and hold the South Mountain YMCA, its assigns and successors, its directors, officers, volunteers, and/or others acting on its behalf harmless from all claims that I/we may have arising from activities that I/we may be involved in with the South Mountain YMCA. I expressly and specifically assume any and all risk of injury, illness, death, or property damage resulting from my/our South Mountain YMCA activities. I hereby give permission for emergency medical treatment to be administered as deemed appropriate. I understand that the South Mountain YMCA does not carry insurance to cover injuries and losses that may befall me/us.

Transportation/Trip Authorization

CODE OF CONDUCT:

1. The YMCA is committed to providing a safe and welcoming environment for all participants and guests. To promote safety and comfort for all, we ask individuals to act appropriately at all times when they are in our facility or participating in our programs. Participants must remember that they represent the Y at all times.
2. We expect participants to behave in a mature and responsible way, and to respect the rights and dignity of others. Our Code of Conduct does not permit language or any action that can hurt or frighten another person, or that falls below a generally accepted standard of conduct.
3. Prohibited actions specifically include:
 - Inappropriate attire. Appropriate attire must be worn at all times.
 - Angry or vulgar language includes swearing, name-calling or shouting.
 - Physical contact with another person in any angry or threatening way.
 - Any demonstration of sexual activity or sexual contact with another person.
 - Harassment or intimidation by words, gestures, body language or any menacing behavior.
 - Theft or behavior that results in the destruction of property.
 - Any other conduct of any inappropriate, threatening or offensive nature.
4. Youth are encouraged to be responsible for their personal comfort and safety, and to ask any person whose behavior threatens their comfort to refrain. If a participant feels uncomfortable in positively confronting the person directly, they should report the behavior to a staff member.
5. Neither loitering nor smoking is permitted inside or outside of the Y.
6. Y staff members are eager to be of assistance. Members and guests should not hesitate to notify any staff member if assistance is needed.
7. In order to carry out these policies, we ask that members and guests identify themselves to staff when asked.
8. The Executive Director or his designee will investigate all reported incidents. Suspension or termination of Y membership privileges may result from a determination by a Y staff member if in their discretion a violation of the Y Member Code of Conduct has occurred.
