Dear Parents of Super Summer Campers,

Hello and Welcome! As we begin a new and wonderful summer experience together, allow us to share some important information with you and your family!

Super Summer Camp begins on June 24th and runs through August 16th. Camp is located at the **Livingston High School at 30 Robert Harp Drive in Livingston**. There is a parking lot on **Madonna Drive**. Please park your vehicle and enter through **Door 12**. (There's a large "Home of the Lancers" sign above the door.) Walk and sign your child in daily. Camp hours are officially 9am to 5pm, however, for your convenience; you may come in as early as 7am and pick up, no later than 6:30pm at the pool you selected for your child to swim in. Please send in your child with a snack (optional), lunch with child's name & grade, water bottles, bathing suit, towel and sneakers daily. Remember to label everything your child brings to camp, including towels, clothes, backpacks, lunch boxes etc. The WE YMCA is not responsible for any lost items. Flip Flops, sandals, crocs, etc are **not** permitted at camp. In additional Town Pool swimmers require their pool badge and a white t shirt daily. Super Summer will offer pizza on Fridays, but your child will still require a drink. *Lunches may also be purchased from Simply Gourmet for non-scheduled trip days, see our website for more details.

Please remember do Not send your child to school with any valuables, including cell phones, DS, ipads etc. The Y will not be held responsible for loss or damage. Also note, your child is at camp, new items are not necessary as things do get dirty or lost.

Prior to the start of camp, you may check our website for the Parent Handbook, Permission to Medicate, calendars, lunch program and camp updates.
